We hereby certify that Century Spring Corp catalog products, to the best of our knowledge, conform To EU Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006, known as REACH, concerning the production and use of chemical substances.

On June 27th, 2024 the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) added new chemicals to the Candidate List, increasing List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) to 241. In communication with vendors, Century Spring Corp has been advised that supplied products/services do not contain any significant amounts of the SVHC 241 substances per below list.

Century Spring Corp., as a spring (article) manufacturer, provides value added services of forming raw material to its final geometry and does not manufacture “substances” or “preparations”; furthermore, they are not involved in any “intentional release of substances”. Therefore, the products are not required to be registered in their existing form.¹

The above-mentioned information is based on supplier certifications/statements and Century Spring’s due diligence. Century Spring Corp will continue to monitor and update the REACH requirements in conjunction with our vendors.
