REACH Compliance Statement

April 4, 2022

The European Directive EC Regulation No 1907/2006 (REACH) refers to European Legislation that requires registration of any REACH-listed articles, substances, chemicals including the substances of very high concern (SVHC) and any restricted chemicals above one metric ton that are manufactured or imported into the EU by the importer of the parts.

As of January 17, 2022, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) has identified 223 “candidate” Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). Under our reading of the regulation and in communication with our material suppliers, to the best of our knowledge, we declare that our products do not contain any of the substances listed on the “Authorization List” (Annex XIV of the REACH regulations) and the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) in any significant amounts as specified by the Annex XVII of Candidate list published by ECHA (European Chemical Agency) 1907/2006/EC.

Century Spring Corp. provides over 35,000 designs of cataloged off-the-shelf products as well as custom made springs. In the event of any REACH-listed articles, substances, and chemicals being used for production of our springs, these are affected by quantities which fall well below the limit values stipulated in REACH. Therefore, we do not require a registration, evaluation or approval to the REACH directive.
